Currently we are using Verizon wireless hotspots, which after 15 gigabyte become data capped or slowed down, once the data is capped we cannot even use zoom or skype, making school unmanageable. I can use 15 gigabyte after just 5 days of my kids in school. It has become very frustrating, and mentally taxing looking for internet solutions in my area.

SC Telcom, has offered possible fiber internet access to my family. They have opened a door for my family to be able to be caught up to the rest of the world finally in terms of high speed internet. Please, help my family and many others in rural Kansas have the ability to receive internet access for our kids sake for schooling, and for many businesses sake, and for laying a foundation to help others in the future have reliable high speed internet.
